Certificate course in Screen Acting

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission will be done on merit basis. There is no age bar, Admission will be offered on the spot subject to availability of seats. Students are given two days to pay their fee online failing with their admission is cancelled.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates who have passed the Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (10+2) of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, or an examination recognized as equivalent there to are eligible to apply for admission.







Movies made by NRAI
